These two classrooms will consist of approximately 50 percent typical peers and approximately 50 percent current Meyer Center students. Typical peers will be placed in these classrooms based on their age.

REQUIREMENTS

- √ 3 or 4 years of age by September 1, 2017
- √ Age appropriate development
- √ Be toilet trained
- √ Parents must provide transportation for typical peers.
