

Part-time Occupational Therapist

At the Meyer Center, our vision is to enrich the lives of children with disabilities so they can reach their maximum potential. We are currently seeking a part-time Occupational Therapist to join our organization. *This position is 3-4 days per week from 7:30am-2:30pm.*

Responsibilities:

- Evaluation and treatment of students ages six months to eight years.
- Completion of treatment plans and Individualized Education Programs (IEPs), annual re-evaluations, quarterly progress notes and daily clinical service notes.
- Collaboration with families, teachers, and other therapists.

Requirements:

- Certified Occupational Therapist and licensed to practice in South Carolina.
- Collaborator with good work ethic with experience working with children.
- Available to work three weeks in June and two weeks in July when school is out.

Salary is based on a school setting and commensurate with level of experience. Benefits include paid leave, retirement, reimbursement for state license fees and annual stipend for continuing education. The Center follows the Greenville County school year schedule.
